Join the Arab master's programme in Democracy and Human Rights in Beirut for one semester from February to May 2023. www.gchumanrights.org/arma

Conditions:

You should be registered in a post-graduate programme in human rights in the Arab region.

Your university should have an agreement with Saint Joseph University of Beirut that allows exchanges of students.

If you are working on your thesis during the exchange semester, you need to register to courses totalling 10 European credits. If you're not working on your thesis during the exchange period, you need to take courses totalling 30 European credits.

The Arab master's programme in Democracy and Human Rights offers the following courses during the second semester of the academic year:

- Gender Policies and Women's Rights (5 European credits)
- Human Rights Lab.: The Missing and Forcibly Disappeared (2 European credits)
- International Criminal Prosecution and Transitional Justice (5 European credits)
- Public Policy & Human Rights (5 European credits)
- Peace and Conflict (4 European credits)
- Politics of Globalisation (5 European credits)
- Refugees, Migration and Mobility Rights (4 European credits)

Scholarships Cover:

- Return ticket from your country to Beirut
- A health insurance
- Visa Fees
- A stipend of 2500 euros
- Waiving of tuition fees

Send your application file to arma@usj.edu.lb. It should include:

- A copy of your passport
- Proof of enrolment in a Human Rights master's programme
- A motivation letter (that includes the courses you want to take)
- A letter of support from the coordinator of the master's programme at your home university
