

LEGALLEAD RESEARCH STAY 2024

Are you a doctoral candidate or master student in legal studies at one of the partner universities of the DAAD Legal Lead project and interested in the work of LegalClinics?

Then take the possibility to apply for a two month research stay and become part of an international network!

The DAAD LegalLead project seeks to support Law Clinics on Female Empowerment and Good Governance and works together with NGOs in all three partner countries.

For your research stay you should develop a research proposal, Ideally together with a partner NGO of the project, your proposal has to convince a professor or researcher at the host institution to host you for the stay

Application

What:

apply for a two-month research stay at Al-Nahrain University, University of Carthage or University of Cologne, the stay has to take place within 2024

How:

Develop a 1-2 Page research proposal at the first step and develop a two-page research proposal at the second step of the application process for a two month research stay, ideally together with a local partner NGO of your Law Clinic

Support:

The scholarship includes travel costs (725,- € to 900,- € depending on country of origin and country of destination), as well as a monthly scholarship (between 934,- € to 1.575,- €, depending on your degree status and country of destination).

There will be a two-step selection process. In a first phase you can register for application online, uploading your cv, a short description of your research idea (0,5 – 1 page) and your desired destination. The deadline for registration is 20 April 2024. Afterwards, short-listed applicants will be asked to develop a 2-page project application addressed to a possible host. The main selection criteria will be the valuation of your proposal by the possible host.

Please upload your application, including

- Short CV
- Project description for your research project in Cologne including possible links to research areas of the University of Cologne (1-2 pages)
- Indication of a possible research cooperation partner at the University of Cologne, send them directly your project description
- A proof that you have English language skills
